Your admission date can be any day, within 30 days, after we have decided on your application.

We aim to assess admission applications [https://www.sra.org.uk/become-solicitor/admission/admission-forms-fees/] within 30 days.

We will only admit you when we are satisfied that you have met Regulation 5.1 of the Authorisation of Individuals Regulations

- need qualifying work experience [https://www.sra.org.uk/becomesolicitor/sqe/qualifying-work-experience-candidates/] to be confirmed
- need a criminal record check outside of the UK [https://www.sra.org.uk/becomesolicitor/admission/screening/].
